Job Description

1. PURPOSE OF JOB:

Collect and serve hot dinners. Could include supervision of children during eating and then in playground. Clean kitchen area and return all containers etc to external provider

2. MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES, TASKS & DUTIES

- I. Take receipt of food from external provider and transport to class zones using hot trolleys
- ii Transferring food onto hot plates
- iii Checking food is correct temperature
- iv Serving up food in correct sized portions and supporting classroom staff serving dinners to pupils
- v Possible supervising in playground after children have finished eating
- vi Recording any incidents or injuries
- vii Cleaning kitchen area and equipment and clearing away all containers etc
- viii Taking back food containers, cutlery, plates etc
